Several Unite the Union regions have launched an appeal to send grassroots sports equipment to Cuban schools. Together with the Cuba Solidarity Campaign we are collecting funds to break the 60 year old blockade which causes shortages in all areas of Cuban life. Money raised will be used to purchase sports equipment specially requested by the Cuban Teaching, Sports and Science Workers' Union (SNTECD).

Everything from balls for football, volleyball and basketball, to bats, teamkits and nets, as well as specialist equipment to enable students with special needs to participate.
